- Make sure travel arrangements to and from school are organised. Practise catching the bus to and from school during the school holidays.
- Organise your child's uniform well before the first day of school. Items of uniform can be purchased online from Midfords.
- Label all uniform, stationery, lunch boxes and drink bottles.
- Learn about school routines and expectations.
- Help your child to develop good study habits and practise organisational skills.
- Ensure your child arrives to school on time each day (preferably by 8:30am).
- Work through the school rules with your child, in particular, promote the correct wearing of the uniform, the responsible use of social media and the non-use of mobile phones at school.
